



UIU organises 1st Inter-University Undergraduate Research Symposium

School of Business and Economics at United International University organised the first ever nation-wide Inter-University Undergraduate Research Symposium. The award giving ceremony was held in the main campus of UIU.

Dr. Debapriya Bhattacharya, Distinguished Fellow, Center for Policy Dialogue (CPD) was present as the chief guest. A.S.M. Mainuddin Monem, Managing Director & CEO, Abdul Monem Economic Zone Limited (AMEZL) and Mohammed Nurul Amin, Managing Director & CEO, Meghna Bank Limited were present as special guests.

A total of 167 undergraduate students from 31 public

and private universities of the country participated in 5 different tracks – Accounting & AIS, Economics, Finance & Banking, Management & HRM and Marketing of the symposium. Top 12 participants from each track were invited to present their research papers. All participants received certificate and gift pack. In each track, the best research paper won the prize of BDT 50,000 followed by BDT 30,000 for the first runner-up and BDT 20,000 for the second runner-up.

It was announced that the 2nd Inter-University Undergraduate Research Symposium will take place between September and November of 2018.
